6.1. LEMC Contact List 2013

6.2. Exercises & Training

- 1/. Helen Kent gave an overview of the training available through the SEMC
- 2/. Graham Bailey (MMG) offered to consult with Jim McNamarra (DFES) to organise further training and conduct an exercise in 2014.

The exercise suggested would be a combination of a truck rollover/explosion on the MMG Golden Grove lease and would include MMG employees, Yalgoo and Paynes Find Bush Fire Brigades and LEMC members.

3/. Graham Bailey (MMG) suggested the Shire may also be interested in running a "Land Search" course in 2014 in conjunction with DFES, MMG, Yalgoo and Paynes Find Bush Fire Brigades.

Details and dates are to be arranged and members will be notified accordingly.

6.3. Emergency Risk Management

The Shire of Yalgoo Emergency Risk Management project for the AWARE grant 2011-12, prepared by Consultant Rae Edwards (EM Planning Solutions) - *The Yalgoo Emergency Risk Management Plan* - analysed and evaluated risks to the Shire.

Levels of risk and priorities for treatment were determined and the risk treatment options identified.

The meeting agreed to adopt the Risk Assessment Report by Shire Consultant Rae Edwards and a draft Recovery Plan will be developed in consultation with Helen Kent (SEMC) and Keith Shaw (CPFS).

Local recovery plan tool kits and checklists will be included in the plan.

6.5. Annual Report

Shire of Yalgoo Annual LEMC Report 2012-2013

The Annual LEMC Business Report was submitted to SEMC on 30 July 2013.



The report was signed by agreed authority with the President Terry Iturbide by LEMC Executive Assistant, Karen Malloch.

As per legislation the Annual Report is required to be signed by the president at the next Ordinary LEMC meeting which will be held on Wednesday 13 November 2013.

The Annual Report was signed by the president at the Ordinary LEMC meeting held on Wednesday 13 November 2013 and was forwarded to the SEMC ON 16 December 2013.

6.6. Funding

Helen Kent (SEMC) explained the various sources of funding available to access by the LEMC for training/conducting exercises in the Shire and to establish a "Recovery Plan".

Dependent on funding, a draft Recovery Plan will be developed in consultation with Helen Kent (SEMC) and Keith Shaw (CPFS).

6.7. Roads & Traffic

Various measures were discussed by the meeting in order to reduce traffic speed, record traffic volume and increase traffic safety awareness on the main Yalgoo/Mullewa/Mt Magnet entrance road.

The meeting suggested that the CEO Sharon Daishe contact Main Roads to replace the rumble strips at the town entrance to alert traffic to reduce vehicle speed.

This measure was carried out and Main Roads replaced the rumble strips at the end of November 2013. Other suggestions from the floor to control traffic flow on the main road were:

- 1/. Increase police infringement notices
- 2/. Build median strips as a calming device to reduce traffic speed
- 3/. Lease/set up flashing lights/speed display signs (the same as the Shire of Morawa have done and which have proven to be very successful.)

6.8. General Business

The meeting agreed to set up a Sub Committee of representatives from the Police, Community & Youth Coordinator, Centacare, Meedac, Yalgoo Primary School, St John Ambulance, Nursing Post and the Shire. Items to be discussed and reported on are:

- 1/. Organise community meetings
- 2/. Disability services available for evacuees
- 3/. 3 day survival plan for residents (minus water, power)
- 4/. Instruction sheets & plans for Yalgoo residents in case of an emergency
- 5/. Local businesses to identify and assess their own risks
- 6/. Organise Bushfire Awareness & preparedness with DFES for protection of property & outlying assets for town residents.
- 7/. Provide supply and delivery forms (re supply)
- 8/. Compile/provide survival kits

The next meeting of the Local Emergency Management Committee will be held on Tuesday 24 March 2014 commencing at 11am at the Yalgoo Railway Station.
